




Wharf Improvements – completed in 2022

1. Ramp

- Added new wheels former ones no longer qualified as wheels
- Replaced tracks longer ones to prevent ramp from coming off

2. Floats

- Covered gaps with new 2x12" boards and heavy rubber mat
- **New industrial rope** to secure floats to dolphin *from Clay W.*

3. Float Hibernation

- Done within a week of noticing limited window of opportunity
- Mussel Scraping on Gibsons Harbour beach 4 people in 30 min!
- New location beside Community Hall for this winter

Site Improvements – completed in 2022

- 1. Replacement of handrails and posts along stairs
- 2. Extensive hillside cleanup of the ivy and blackberries
- 3. Benches on patio built from surplus wharf lumber
- 4. Installation of first of two historical panels



 - Thanks to Mike Bothma, Bruno Huber, board members, & all other helpers for continuing to take care of the wharf!











Hall Funds → GWA

- · Since the SCRD covered all Hall restoration expenses, Mary Burns recommended the Hall funds be formally transferred to the GWA
- The five households that donated to the Hall Restoration fund have kindly approved this reallocation of their donations to the GWA
- The major part of the Hall funds were raised in a concert organized by David King in 2016 ->
- With respect to those people that participated and contributed to that concert, we will table a motion for this reallocation of the Hall funds



GWA Financial Health

The board (and most members) do not want to raise annual membership donations and watercraft fees

Other ideas to raise funds:

- (1) reduce gardening and maintenance costs via volunteers work crews
- (2) encourage more households to pay annual donation
- (3) encourage greater participation in fundraising events (Bye Bye Blues, Bingo!) and buying GWA merch. (Granthams Cards & Tshirts?)
